

You're Invited to... Skip-A-Payment!

Slide into savings and gain a little freedom this holiday season with some extra cash!

Be on the lookout for the "Holiday Skip a Payment" arriving in your mailbox. "The Holiday Skip a Payment" program is only available on certain loan types, so it's possible you may not receive one for every loan you have with Rocket City Federal Credit Union. All real estate, share and certificate secured loans, open-end loans, any consumer loan less the three months old are excluded from the program. Loans with G.A.P. insurance having previously skipped six payments are also excluded. Only one Skip-A-Pay allowed per every six months.

A small processing fee of \$35 will be charged for each loan "skipped" and interest charges will continue to accrue. "Skipped" loan payments that are set for payroll deduction will be applied to savings instead of your loan when the payment is received. By "skipping" a payment, the maturity/final payment date as disclosed on the note, truth in lending disclosure and/or security agreement will be extended beyond the date originally disclosed.

TIPS TO AVOID ONLINE SHOPPING SCAMS



A whopping 40% of online scamming occurs during the end of the year, holiday season. To help ensure you don't fall victim to scammers, follow these simple tips (Fredman, 2015).

Look for HTTPS. Make sure the web site you're ordering from starts with "https" and not "http." The "s" stands for secure connection. And, never use public Wi-Fi to enter any account or card information (Fredman, 2015).

Use a Credit Card. Paying with a credit card yields better protection against scams, and responsibly managing a credit card can boost your credit score (Schulz, 2015). You can visit our office or go online to apply for a credit card at www. RocketCityFCU.org.

Read Reviews. When ordering from a new website or vendor, search for related reviews or scams.

Mix well. Put into cookie press, using the star attachment. Bake at 400° for 10 minutes or until crisp. Store in tins. Will keep for several months.
